#### **Availability**

Service to accounts where at least one person resides for at least part of a year. May include associated well(s), outbuildings and other structures or loads. Maximum connected load under this rate may not exceed that which may be supplied from a fifty (50) kVA distribution transformer. Must have a separately metered, permanently installed heating unit as the primary heat source for the residence. Midwest will provide the meter to record the usage by the heat source – member must pay for the cost of installing the wiring for the meter. Subject to current conditions and safety standards established by the National Electric Safety Code, Nebraska State Electrical Division and Midwest.

Single-phase, sixty (60) Hertz, alternating current, at available secondary voltages.

#### **Electric Heat Discount**

Credited only during the months of October through April.

Credit for energy through Heat Meter ..... -\$ 0.025 per kWh

#### **Terms of Payment**

Payment is due on the 25<sup>th</sup> of the month following the period for which the bill is calculated. If the 25<sup>th</sup> falls on a weekend or holiday, the due date will be the next business day after the 25<sup>th</sup>.

A late charge of \$10 or 10%, whichever is greater, will be assessed on any account not paid on or before the due date. In addition, accounts still owing a balance at month end will be charged an additional 1.33% interest (interest is not charged on the penalty charges).

Electric Heat Meter will be a separate account in rate 262 with the accounts joined with a Multi-Meter setup in Meridian.

#### **Availability**

Service to accounts where at least one person resides for at least part of a year. May include associated well(s), outbuildings and other structures or loads. Maximum connected load under this rate may not exceed that which may be supplied from a fifty (50) kVA distribution transformer. Available when member has a renewable generation source installed behind the meter, not to exceed 25 kW AC. Subject to current conditions and safety standards established by the National Electric Safety Code, Nebraska State Electrical Division and Midwest. Midwest will accept Net Metering service applications up to 1% of our average monthly peak system load.

#### **Type of Service**

Single-phase, sixty (60) Hertz, alternating current, at available secondary voltages.

#### **Usage Calculation**

At the end of each billing period, the energy the Member sells back to Midwest will be subtracted from the energy purchased from Midwest by the Member. If the net amount is delivered to the Member (more purchased than sold), the bill will be generated based on that net amount. If the net amount is received by Midwest (more sold than purchased), the net amount purchased will be credited back to the Member at Midwest's current wholesale cost of energy. The member is responsible for the Facility Charge regardless of the net amount.

First 500 kWh (if net is delivered).....\$ 0.115 per kWh  
Over 500 kWh (if net is delivered) .....\$ 0.080 per kWh
